Course Framework Note:	<p>1. In accordance with the University Academic Regulations, undergraduate students are required to pass the proficiency assessments in Chinese Language, English Language, Information Technology, Physical Fitness and Basic Professional Competence, and to complete the department's Advanced Applied Chinese Internship in order to be eligible for graduation.</p> <p>2. Of the 12 credits of university-required General Education courses, students must complete one course in each of the three core domains—Humanities, Social Sciences, and Natural Sciences (2 credits each)—as well as one course (3 credits, required) from the Interdisciplinary Exploration course cluster under the newly established Interdisciplinary Exploration and Self-Directed Learning domain, for a total of 4 courses and 9 credits. In addition, students must select two courses from the extended courses in the Humanities, Social Sciences, and Natural Sciences domains, and/or from the Self-Directed Learning courses in the Interdisciplinary Exploration and Self-Directed Learning domain. These two courses may not both be from the same domain and must total at least 3 credits. General Education requirements must total 12 credits. Any credits taken in excess of this requirement shall not be counted as electives outside the department or as other professional elective credits.</p> <p>3. The minimum number of credits required for graduation is 128, including 12 university-required credits, 12 General Education credits, 62 required departmental credits, and at least 42 departmental elective credits. The credit load per semester is as follows: for the first, second, and third academic years, students may enroll in 12 to 25 credits per semester; for the fourth academic year, students must enroll in at least 9 credits per semester. Students who achieve a semester grade point average of 80 or above, and who receive approval from the Department Chair, may enroll in one to two additional courses beyond the maximum credit limit in the following semester.</p> <p>4. This department does not impose course prerequisite restrictions (course blocking).</p> <p>5. The elective courses listed in this curriculum framework are retroactively applicable to students admitted prior to Academic Year 114(2025-26).</p> <p>6. Credits earned from elective courses offered by other departments (including up to 2 credits from the Teacher Education Program) may be recognized, subject to approval by the Department Chair, with a maximum of 20 credits. This policy is retroactively applicable to students admitted prior to Academic Year 114(2025-26).</p> <p>7. Credit transfers for courses shall be processed in accordance with the University's Regulations Governing Student Applications for Course Credit Transfer.</p> <p>8. Newly added required courses may be recognized as elective credits for students who were not originally enrolled under the revised curriculum framework, and this provision is retroactively applicable to students admitted prior to Academic Year 114(2025-26).</p> <p>9. Focused Course Programs not listed in the graduation curriculum framework may be recognized as credits from outside the department.</p>
